#### **Terms and Conditions**

## Payment and Cancellation

To reserve a place on your Blue Mountains course, Allie Pepper Adventures requires a deposit of 50% of the course fee. The full balance of the course fee must be paid for your place to be confirmed on the course. Allie Pepper Adventures requires full payment to be made 15 days prior to course start date. Payment must be made in full if the booking is taken less than 15 days before course commencement. Costs are quoted in \$AU and payment may be made by direct deposit to:

The following fees apply on cancellation:

- 15 days or more before the course there is no charge

## **Poor Weather and Minimum Numbers**
